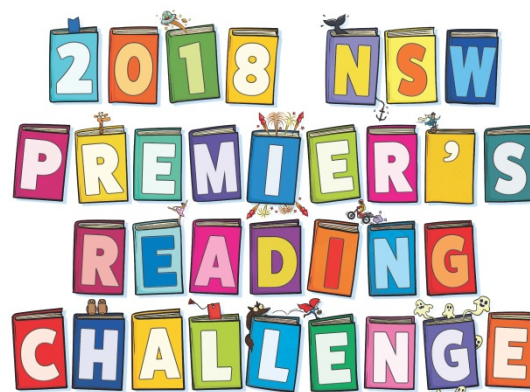
National Day of Action Against Bullying and Violence
